5. **PRESIDENT'S REPORT**

- A. Recreation Grant Awarded for the Kitchen So excited to announce we were granted \$57,000 for our kitchen renovation. We are going to tackle it piece by piece. Lori is going to call Meals on Wheels
- B. Field of Honor Flagpole We ordered one but we had to return it because it was missing pieces. It is due to arrive this week and we have several volunteers to help set it up. A member asked about the flag pole that was donated in October of 2023. Due to the limited number of volunteers and that the pole needed to be moved, painted and then installed, the membership determined that purchasing a new pole would be a better investment.
- C. Signage We will be asking for proposals from three companies on pricing and timing to get our electric sign out front.
- D. Fall Art and Craft Show Vendors asked if we would consider having another one in November. We had over 30 vendors and raised \$1,040 in table fees.
 - E. Curry Accounting Services When Lori took this position, she was told the accounting was done free of charge. However, he missed filing paperwork to South Carolina. When called he said he could no longer do the work for free. After several conversations with the accounting department, the invoices were being sent to Hester Store Rd and were never received. The total invoice cost was over \$6,000. The Field of Honor was called into question on the money owed and the money coming in. - F. Dacusville Sew ciety: Georgia Shelton We have had about 5-6 new people come into the room. They seem to come in at the same time. We have a good showing of people sewing and a lot of them are children.
